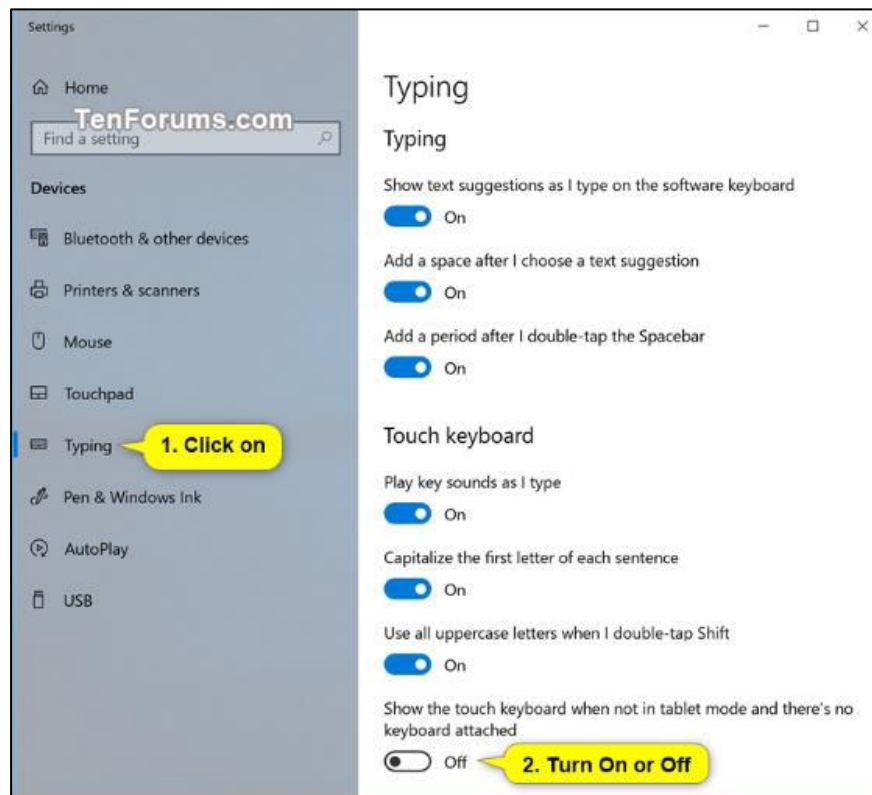


# [Issue Descriptions]: How to Show Virtual Keyboard on Windows 10

First method

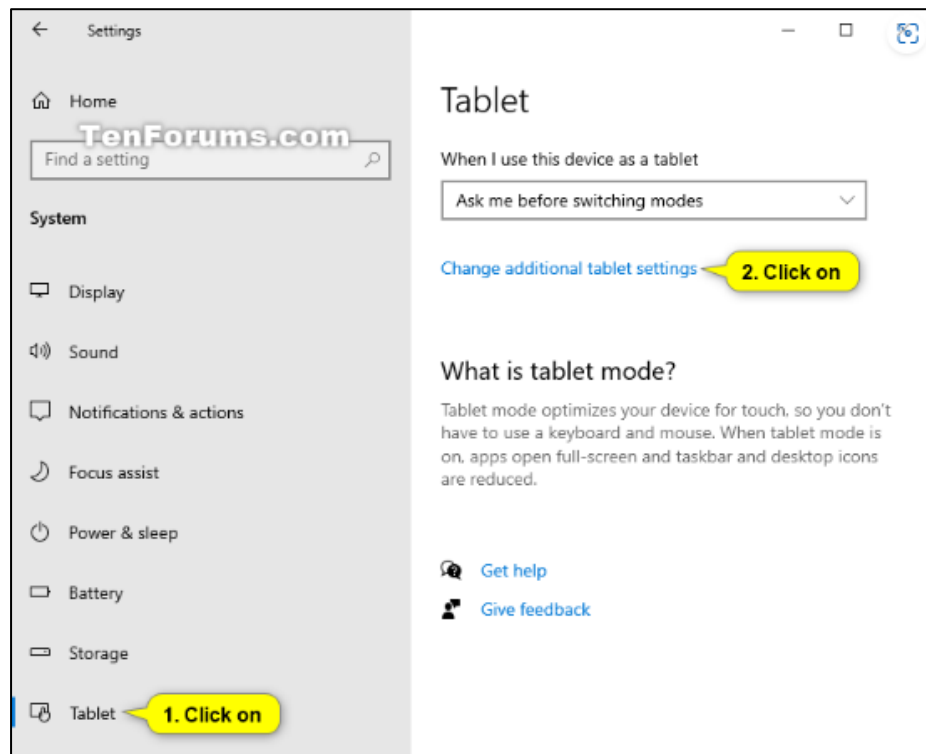
1. Open [Settings](#), and click on [Devices](#).
2. Choose [Typing](#) on the left side, and turn on “Show the touch keyboard when not in tablet mode and there’s no keyboard attached” under the [Touch Keyboard](#) sub-menu.



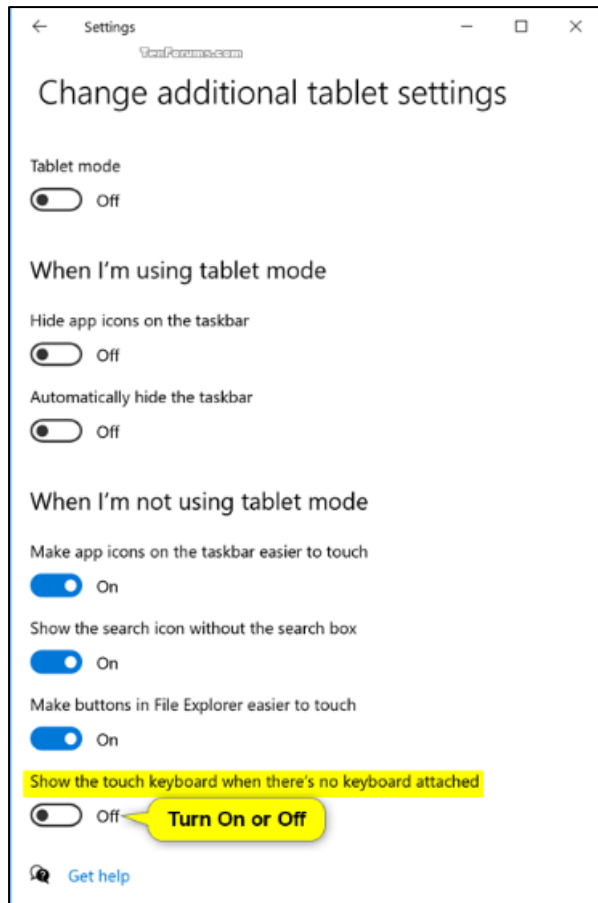
3. Save the changes and exit.

## Second method

1. Open [Settings](#), and click on the [System](#) icon.
2. Choose [Tablet](#) on the left side, and click on the [Change additional tablet settings](#) on the right side.



3. Turn on "Show the touch keyboard when there's no keyboard attached" under [When I'm not using tablet mode](#) sub-menu.



4. Save the changes and exit.
